

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## OUR PURPOSE

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We at Timber Oaks believe that all people, especially older adults should be able to live with dignity and comfort. We know that the transition from home to a community setting can be difficult. We believe that our professional and caring attitude can make this transition easier and indeed a positive experience.

## WHO WE ARE

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Timber Oaks is a Community Based Residential Facility (CBRF) with a Class C License. When you hear the term group home, often what you are hearing about is a CBRF. Group homes serve people who are not able to live independently at home but do not need 24 hour nursing care that nursing homes provide. Typically a resident at a group home will require less than three hours of direct nursing care per week. However, residents of group homes can receive as much personal care as he or she needs. Having a Class C license means that Timber Oaks can serve residents with a wide variety of personal needs including dressing, bathing, wheelchairs and walkers, incontinence, confusion related to dementia or Alzheimer's and other infirmities of aging. Timber Oaks has twelve private rooms

and nine semi-private rooms that can be decorated according to the tastes of the resident. We prepare and serve three nutritious and delicious meals daily with snacks and juice in between. Laundry services are also provided. We have daily group and individual activities as well as community outings. Nursing services are provided twice a week and more often as necessary. Finally, we will assist the resident to secure any other services that may be needed such as podiatry care, eye care and therapy services.

## WHO WE SERVE

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Timber Oaks serves older adults. All residents of Timber Oaks need varying levels of care and our staff is trained to treat each resident individually to assure that the needs of each individual is met.

## OUR VALUES & BELIEFS

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1. The care of our residents is always our number one priority.
2. Our residents will receive polite and courteous care. We will always consider the feelings and emotions of residents when delivering care/treatment to assure quality care and kindness.
3. Our residents will receive prompt care. We will anticipate the needs of our

residents to the best of our ability to assure prompt care/treatment.

4. We will always be patient with our residents. We expect that our residents will need varying levels of care and we will patiently deal with the needs of our residents.
5. We will pamper our residents. In addition to our daily activities and routine we will take time to visit with residents or do something special for our residents.

## TYPES OF PLACEMENT

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Timber Oaks is very flexible in meeting the needs of our residents. Of course we are available for long term placements for those individuals that decide they would like permanent security of care that Timber Oaks offers. Also, we are available for short term stays for individuals that need to recuperate from hospital or nursing home stays but will eventually return home. In addition, we are able to accommodate those families and individuals that need respite care. If you or a loved one need our services for a weekend, week, or even longer, Timber Oaks will be available to meet your needs. Finally, Timber Oaks is adjacent to Oak Ridge Care Center, a skilled nursing home that offers Medicare Rehabilitation. In the event that more care is needed, the residents of Timber Oaks will have first priority for service at Oak Ridge.
